

## Beyond the Bridge Regatta, Notice of Race (NOR)

Saturday June 29th, 2019

Organizing Authority: Burlington Sailing and Boating Club (BS&BC)

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats. Additional classes may be added if a minimum of 5 boats register.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering on-line ([www.burlbay.com](http://www.burlbay.com)) A signed waiver form must be received prior to the close of registration.

### 3. REGISTRATION AND FEES

3.1 Boats can register on-line at [www.burlbay.ca](http://www.burlbay.ca).

3.2 Required fees is \$40.00 per boat plus HST.

3.3 Scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 1100 hrs. There will be no warning signals made after 1500 hrs.

4. MEASUREMENT Each boat may be required to produce a valid measurement certificate.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be posted online ([www.burlbay.com](http://www.burlbay.com)) and on the official notice board. Print out your own copy of the Sailing Instructions. No paper copies will be provided.

7. THE VENUE Racing will take place on Hamilton Harbour.

8. THE COURSES The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward or windward/leeward/triangle. Description of the courses will appear in the Sailing Instructions. Floating marks and fixed marks on the Bay may be used.

9. SCORING One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.1 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. (b) When four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

11. PRIZES

12 Flags will be given to boats placing first, second and third in each class with five or more entries; to those placing first and second in classes with four entries and to the first place in classes with three entries.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. INSURANCE Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per incident or the equivalent.
