Shark Program Membership and Fees

The Shark Program runs from April 13, 2019 – October 15, 2019. This includes boat preparation, lift in, sailing, haul out and winterizing.

Intermediate (Shark Program) Membership – Crew **\$325.00** plus HST (13%)

- The intermediate membership introduces members to sailing with the help of BS&BC sailing mentors. The Shark Program encourages those interested in sailing to enjoy sailing and develop sailing skills without having to own a keelboat. In addition, members learn about boat care & maintenance, meet other sailors and join in Club activities as part of the BSBC sailing community. All members must complete 10 hours volunteering within the Shark Program.

Intermediate (Shark Program – First Mate) Membership – Crew **\$75.00** plus HST(13%)

- BS&BC believes sailing is a family sport and we encourage members to bring a first mate along. With the purchase of an Intermediate membership your 'First Mate' may join for a discounted fee. The First Mate Intermediate membership encompasses all that the Intermediate (Shark Program) Membership offers. This allows the First Mate to learn how to sail along with their significant other. All members must complete 10 hours volunteering within the Shark Program.

Use of Shark program boats (Senior Members only) – Crew or Skipper **\$150.00** plus HST (13%)

- There are two membership categories in the Shark Program ... Crew and Skipper. You enter the program as Crew and learn to sail. Once you achieve Skipper status you are able to take the BS&BC boats out your own in the bay. All Skippers must become a Senior Member (other fees apply) in order to enjoy the Club keel boats on their own. All Senior Shark members must complete 10 hours volunteering within the Shark Program (total 20 hours).
